WHEREAS the City of Mount Vernon, Ohio employs a Safety-Service Director to act as the administrator for the government of the City of Mount Vernon, Ohio; and

WHEREAS a majority of members of the Council of the City of Mount Vernon have lost confidence in the ability of the Safety-Service Director, Mr. Richard Dzik, to accurately and fairly perform his duties in the best interests of the City; and

WHEREAS a majority of members of the Council of the City of Mount Vernon assert that the relationship between Council and Safety-Service Director appears irreconcilable; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mount Vernon, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Council of the City of Mount Vernon, Ohio hereby expresses its non-confidence in the current City Safety-Service Director and recommends that the Mayor of Mount Vernon sever the relationship with Mr. Richard Dzik and pursue an alternative administrator in order to advance the interests of the City of Mount Vernon as a whole.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public, peace, health and safety, and to allow the City to move forward, and said Resolution shall, therefore, become effective upon its date of passage and approval by the Mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected to the Council of the City of Mount Vernon; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

WHEREAS, the Knox County Budget Commission has waived the requirement that the taxing authority of a subdivision or other taxing unit adopt a tax budget as provided under section 5705.28 of the Revised Code.

WHEREAS, the City of Mount Vernon will be required to furnish a modified budget only for those funds that receive tax levied taxes. Prior to December 31, 2020, an estimate of resources and other income shall be prepared and filed with the Knox County Budget Commission.

AN ORDINANCE SETTING HOURLY COMPENSATION FOR SEASONAL PERSONNEL IN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mount Vernon Fire Department conducts annual testing of its hoses and fire hydrants; and

WHEREAS, these tests are usually conducted by Mount Vernon firefighters working overtime; and

WHEREAS, the use of seasonal employees to conduct this testing will save City resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mount Vernon, State of Ohio:
